Furthermore I agree to release, defend, and hold harmless Greentrike, including any firm, partner, or event sponsor publishing and / or distributing the finished product in whole or in part, from and against any claims, damages or liability arising from or related to the use of the photographs. Health & Safety Policy:

To ensure the safety of our visitors and staff, the Children's Museum at JBLM requires that anyone entering the facility be free of the following symptoms that are related to the COVID-19 virus. Symptoms include, but are not limited to, fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea. By reserving tickets, you confirm that all members of your group:

- Are not currently experiencing symptoms related to the COVID-19 virus.

- Within the past 14 days, have not been within close contact with anyone with a confirmed case of COVID-19 or COVID-like symptoms (close contact is being within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period with a person).
- Have not had a positive COVID-19 test for active virus in the past 10 days, or awaiting results of a COVID-19 test.
- And, within the past 14 days, have not had a public health or medical professional advise any member to self-monitor, self-isolate, or self-quarantine because of concerns about COVID-19 infection.

Additionally, by reserving a ticket, you are agreeing all members of your group will adhere to the following:

- Wear a face covering as mandated by the WA Secretary of Health that covers your nose and mouth throughout the duration of your visit both indoors and out. **Children’s Museum at JBLM requires masks for ages 5+ and highly recommends masks for ages 3+. Medical exemptions and mesh masks are not accepted.**
- Maintain proper social distancing (6-feet) from others not in your group.
- Follow directional signage.
- Use hand sanitizer upon entry and allow Children’s Museum at JBLM to take your temperature.

Cancellation Policy:

By reserving a ticket, you are agreeing to the following cancellation policy. If you are unable to attend during your reserved time, please contact us within 48 hours before the start time to cancel and reschedule your visit.

If you are unable to adhere to the policy, Children’s Museum at JBLM will happily reschedule your visit for a time you are feeling better.
